

Delay To Compliance With Building Envelope Performance Target

1. DELAY TO COMPLIANCE WITH BUILDING ENVELOPE PERFORMANCE TARGET

Further to Program Technical Bulletin 06 item 1, and with reference to section 2.2.2 Energy Efficiency Targets, the date on which homes shall comply with a gross space heat loss target of at least 30% improvement has been delayed until at least July 1, 2025. This is to allow further analysis to be conducted and ensure a smooth transition to the new building envelope metric. Participants may continue to use either of the following Building Envelope Performance Targets:

- a. Gross Space Heat Loss: The proposed house shall have a gross space heat loss that is at least 25% lower than the corresponding EnerGuide reference house, or
- b. Annual Space Heating Energy Consumption: The proposed house when modelled with the standard mechanical conditions given in Table 2 below shall have annual space heating energy consumption that is at least 33% lower than the corresponding EnerGuide reference house.

The new effective date will be published as soon as possible.
